



MARE CHECKLIST

DEFRA regulations and the Breeders Quality Mark have meant that we are obliged to request the following for every mare that comes to Stud.

Please use this checklist to ensure that your mare is ready to travel to Stud – thank you.

BEFORE TRAVELLING TO STUD:

Have the following been posted / faxed / emailed to West Kingston Stud in good time before sending your mare? **Please note: ALL** of these will be required prior to your mare's arrival at Stud:

- CEM swab results – dated in current breeding season
- EVA & EIA blood test results – dated within 30 days of arrival at Stud
- Nomination Form – completed in full and signed
(**Important:** Please include all known breeding and health information)
- Declaration of Health – completed and signed by your vet

In addition, please check the following:

- Have you confirmed your mare's arrival date and approximate time with the Stud?
- If appropriate, has your insurance company been advised that you are sending your mare to Stud?
- If you have arranged to use frozen/chilled semen not stored/available at West Kingston Stud, have you made all arrangements concerning payment and delivery to West Kingston Stud in time for insemination and advised the Stud accordingly?
- Have you had your mare's hind shoes removed?
- If your mare's booster vaccinations are due while at Stud, have you asked the Stud to arrange this for you?

TRAVELLING TO STUD:

Current DEFRA and EU regulations now state that all horses must travel with their Passports and that the declaration concerning administration of medicinal treatments is signed by the owner:

- Passport ready to travel with the mare?
- Has the Declaration been signed in the Passport concerning administration of medicinal treatments (DEFRA regulations)?
