GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The agreed daily charge includes full livery and exercising of a stallion to the owner's requirements. The charge also includes an initial semen collection and evaluation to establish a suitable freezing method.
2. Unless instructed otherwise, semen will be collected as often as a stallion's sperm reserves allow during a collection period. In practice, the most cost-effective schedule is usually once every 48 hours or 3 to 4 collections per week. All ejaculates in which semen characteristics are within acceptable limits will be processed and frozen. Substandard ejaculates will be discarded before processing and a charge will be made for the cost of collection only. After processing, the post-thaw motility, concentration and longevity of each ejaculate will be evaluated. No doses of frozen semen will be recommended for use commercially unless the semen meets the minimum standards set by the centre. Although every effort will be made to freeze each stallion's semen to the highest standard, no guarantee can be given for either the number of useable doses produced or for the conception rate that the semen will achieve when inseminated. At the end of the collection period, a full report on semen characteristics of each ejaculate will be prepared.
3. Health tests will be carried out to meet the requirements set by the importing countries as nominated in section IV above. Every effort will be made to meet the known requirements at the time of collection but no guarantee can be given that changes to the regulations may not be made in the future which might render the semen ineligible for import to the country for which it was intended.
4. For stallions whose semen is intended for export and who may, therefore, be at the centre for several weeks, a **deposit of £1500** (for worldwide export stallions) or **£750** (for others) is required to cover the cost of health checks and the initial period at the centre. If, after evaluation, it appears that a stallion's semen is unsuitable for freezing, he may be withdrawn from the scheme without further charge. The balance of any money owing should be paid when a stallion is collected from the centre. VAT is charged at the prevailing rate.
5. Routine veterinary and farriery attention carried out at the owner's request will be charged at cost. Non-routine or emergency veterinary requirements will be referred to Willesley Equine Clinic who will charge the owner directly.
6. If the stallion is insured, his policy should cover at least death as a result of injury, illness, disease, theft or mysterious disappearance. Cover should include veterinary fees and liability. The insurers must be informed and West Kington Stud Stallion Centre must be noted on the policy whilst the stallion is resident at the centre.
7. Each stallion should be provided with the following items clearly marked: **rugs as required, grooming kit, covering bridle and head collar.**
8. Every care will be taken whilst the stallion is at the centre but no responsibility can be accepted for accident, theft or disease.
