Forms

A properly completed Nomination Form and Vet's Declaration will be required for every mare visiting the Stud, regardless of the Stud service being provided. These should be sent to the Stud prior to arrival of the mare.

Health Tests

All mares must be swabbed for CEM and blood tested for EVA and EIA within 30 days prior to arrival and the certificates forwarded to the Stud. Mares will not be allowed onto the Stud without prior receipt of satisfactory test results.

Vet's Declaration

The Declaration of Health must also be signed by the owner's vet and sent to the Stud prior to arrival of the mare.

Passports

All mares should have their ULN (Unique Life Number) in their passports, as well as up-to-date Equine Flu and Tetanus Toxoid vaccination records. Mares must travel with their passports.

Blacksmith

Mares and foals will have their feet trimmed when necessary and the owner will be charged accordingly. **All mares to have their hind shoes removed prior to arrival at the Stud.**

Worming

Mares and foals will be wormed every 4 to 6 weeks and the owner will be charged accordingly.

Vet Treatments & Fees

All expenses incurred for visits, examinations and medicines are payable direct to Willesley Equine Clinic who offer mare breeding packages. In the event that emergency veterinary attention is necessary, all efforts will be made to contact the owner prior to treatment. However, if the owner is not available for whatever reason, Willesley Equine Clinic will administer the treatment they consider to be most appropriate and in the best interests of the mare and/or foal and charge the owner accordingly.

Visiting Mares

The Stud reserves the right to feed or stable grass mares as they consider most beneficial to the care of the mare and/or foal. Please see the *Information & Guidance* notes for details of routine testing of foals, which will be charged to the owner's account. Mares and foals at West Kington Stud will receive every possible care, attention and supervision, but no responsibility can be taken for accident or disease. All mares are tried and served at their owners' risk and no responsibility can be accepted for injury, damage or loss. The Stud reserves the right to refuse any mare without reason. The Stud reserves the right to charge up to 50% surcharge on keep fees for mares not collected within two weeks of notification.

Checklist

Please use the Checklist provided with the Stud Pack to ensure that your mare is ready to travel to Stud. **Please note** that West Kington Stud is a DEFRA-approved stallion station and operates according to the HBLB Codes of Practice on CEM, EVA, EHV and Guidelines on Strangles. As such, we will be unable to accept your mare onto the Stud without all necessary documentation and satisfactory health tests.

Stud Season

West Kington Stud opens to foaling and visiting mares on 1st April and will close on 31st August. All owners will be required to make arrangements to take their mares home prior to this date.
