

FOALING PACKAGE 2025

Set fee of £197.50 + VAT

This fee includes:

- **Post foaling examination of mare and foal**

The mare is examined for any damage to the external reproductive tract*, to assess her milk supply and general wellbeing. The afterbirth is examined for completeness and any abnormality. The foal is examined for general wellbeing including colostrum intake, navel abnormality, meconium status and orthopaedic conformation. The foal is given tetanus anti-toxin.

- **IgG Blood sample from the foal**

This checks that the foal has taken sufficient colostrum to ensure good immunity.

- **Foal I.D. and microchip for registration and passport****

*An ultrasound scan and endometrial swab is recommended at foal heat, 7-10 days after foaling, to ensure the uterus has recovered well. This is not included in the package.

** By requesting this Foaling Package, your foal will be microchipped and we will require the following from you:

- Details of which Stud Book you would like your foal registered with
- The registered name of the foal
- The cover certificate (which must be obtained from the stallion owner/agent, not necessarily the stud where the mare is foaling down)

The package fee must be paid in full before work commences and the fee plan is not transferrable to the following season.
