GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF BUSINESS

Booking Form:	A completed & signed Booking Form and Nomination Form (if applicable) is required for every mare visiting West Kington Stud Ltd (the Stud). This MUST be sent to the Stud prior to the mare's arrival.
Health Tests:	ALL MARES MUST be swabbed for CEM and blood tested for EVA within 30 days prior to arrival and the certificates forwarded to the Stud. Mares will not be allowed onto the Stud without prior receipt of satisfactory test results.
Vaccinations:	ALL MARES MUST have a current Equine Influenza/Tetanus vaccination dated within 6 months of arrival at the Stud. If a further 6-month vaccination falls due during the mare's stay, we will vaccinate as a matter of course, with cost to your account.
Declaration of Health:	The Declaration of Health MUST be completed and signed by the owner's vet and sent to the Stud within 48 hours prior to arrival.
Passport:	It is a legal requirement for all mares to travel with a valid passport. All mares should have their UELN (Unique Equine Life Number) in their passports, as well as up-to-date Flu & Tetanus vaccination records.
Shoes & Farrier:	ALL MARES MUST have their hind shoes removed prior to arrival at the Stud. ALL MARES AND FOALS will have their feet trimmed (and fronts shod if applicable) when necessary and the owner will be charged accordingly.
Worming:	ALL MARES and FOALS will be wormed routinely, in accordance with the Stud's worming protocols and the owner will be charged accordingly.
Vet Treatment/Fees:	All expenses incurred for visits, examinations, medication and Breeding/Foaling Packages are payable direct to B&W Equine Vets. In the event that emergency veterinary attention is necessary, every effort will be made to contact the owner prior to treatment. If contact cannot be made, B&W Equine Vets will administer whatever treatment they consider to be most appropriate and in the best interests of the mare and/or foal and charge the owner accordingly.
Care of Mares & Foals:	The Stud reserves the right to feed or stable grass mares if they consider this beneficial to the care of the mare and/or foal. All mares and foals will receive every possible care, attention and supervision, but the Stud accepts no liability for accident or disease. All mares are tried and served at their owner's risk and no responsibility can be accepted for injury, damage or loss. All mares will be served by Al.
Foal ID & Microchip:	ALL FOALS will be microchipped and their markings drawn ready for transfer to the appropriate passport application forms. This service is included in the Foaling Package.
Right of Admission:	The Stud reserves the right to refuse any mare without reason.
Payment:	A final account will be produced and must be settled in full prior to the mare leaving the Stud. Mare owners using a third party to collect their mare must settle all accounts in advance of collection. VAT is charged, where applicable, on all accounts.
Insurance:	The Stud accepts no responsibility for visiting mares and foals and does not carry insurance cover. It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that their mare is adequately insured.
Stud Season:	The Stud opens for foaling mares on 1 st March and mares for AI on 1 st April and closes to all mares on 31 st August. All owners will be notified and required to collect their mares prior to the closure date.
Late Collection:	The Stud reserves the right to charge a surcharge of up to 50% on keep fees for any mare not collected within two weeks of notification.
Arrivals/Departures:	You must give 48 hours' notice of your mare's arrival and departure. Arrivals/Departures are only permitted between 09:00 and 17:00 and arrival/departure outside of these times may incur a £50 surcharge (except in exceptional circumstances).
Equipment:	The owner MUST provide a FIELD-SAFE headcollar. No rugs/tack to be left at WKS without prior permission
Photography:	Photos will be taken of your mare on admission and discharge and of your foal following birth. We may take photos for teaching, social media and marketing purposes unless otherwise requested (see below).

MARE CHECKLIST Please use this checklist to ensure that your mare is ready to travel to WKS.

Before travelling -

1		* CEM swab results – dated in current breeding season
2		* EVA blood test results – dated within 30 days of arrival at Stud
3		* Flu/Tet Vaccination – <i>must be up to date and dated within 12 months</i> of <i>arrival at Stud.</i>
4		* Declaration of Health – <i>completed and signed by your vet</i>
5		* Booking Form – completed in full & signed . Please include all known breeding and health information.
	*	PLEASE NOTE: Mares will NOT be allowed on Stud until documents 1- 5 have been provided.
6		Completed & Signed Nomination Form (if you are sending your mare to be covered by a stallion resident at WKS)
7		Confirm your mare's arrival date and approximate time with the Stud.
8		If appropriate, inform your insurance company that you are sending your mare to Stud.
9		If you have arranged to use frozen/chilled semen not stored/available at West Kington Stud, confirm delivery (in time for insemination) and advise the Stud accordingly.
10		Remove hind shoes from all mares.
11		If your mare's booster vaccinations are due while at stud, please make the Stud aware and our vet will vaccinate (at your cost).
12		Check passport is ready to travel with the mare.
		Travelling regulations - Current DEFRA and EU regulations now state that all horses must travel with their Passports and that the declaration concerning administration of medicinal freatments is signed by the owner.



INFORMATION & GUIDANCE

PRE-ENTRY HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Pre-Entry Health Tests

The following tests are <u>compulsory</u> for all mares coming Stud and satisfactory negative results must be received prior to the mare's arrival:-

- Clitoral swab (CEM) taken in the current breeding season this test is required for all mares.
- **EVA blood test** taken within 30 days of arrival at Stud this test is required for all mares. If the mare has been EVA vaccinated, we will require sight of the pre-vaccination blood test results, as well as a copy of the vaccination record showing that annual boosters are up-to-date prior to arrival at Stud.

Declaration of Health

This <u>MUST</u> be completed by your vets within 48 hours prior to your mare's arrival at Stud. Mares will not be allowed onto the Stud if these have not been received.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Passports

By law, all horses now must travel with their Passports and vaccinations given must be recorded in the Passport, including Rotavirus, EHV 1-4, Flu & Tetanus, EVA, etc. Also, the relevant declaration concerning administration of medicinal treatments must also be signed by the owner.

Booking Forms, Nomination Forms & Health Certificates

Copies of all forms, certificates and information should be sent to us by email in the first instance, to ensure that we have sight prior to arrival of your mare. However, we do also need the originals, which can either be sent by post or travel with the mare along with her Passport.

VACCINATIONS

Flu & Tet

No mare will be allowed onto the Stud without a valid Equine Flu & Tetanus Toxoid vaccination record dated within six months of arrival at stud. If the vaccination falls due during your mare's stay at Stud, we will vaccinate as a matter of course and charge to your account.

EHV & Rotavirus - Foaling Mares

- EHV 1-4 (Equine Herpes Virus) vaccinations are recommended for foaling mares visiting West Kington Stud. Vaccinations are due at months 5, 7 and 9 after covering date. Please advise us if the final vaccination is due while your mare is at Stud and we will arrange for this to be done.
- There has been an increase in the incidence of Rotavirus throughout the UK, so it is now recommended for foaling mares to receive the Rotavirus vaccine at months 8, 9 and 10.

ROUTINE TESTS AT STUD

- New-born foals will be routinely tested at approximately 18-36 hours old for IGG levels to check that the foal has
 adequate immunity from the mare. We recommend that foals born elsewhere should also be tested at
 approximately 24 hours old for IGG levels.
- For mares coming to Stud with foals at foot, we will routinely test the foals for Rotavirus on arrival, before being admitted to the herd.

WORMING

We routinely worm all mares and foals as this is extremely important for optimal herd health. If your mare/foal is wormed during their stay with us, this will be charged to your account. If you regularly worm your mare at home, please ensure the relevant information (date of worming and product used) is recording on your booking form.

ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION & EMBRYO TRANSFER

ALL mares resident at West Kington Stud are covered by Artificial Insemination, a process where semen is placed directly into the mare's uterus, via a catheter through the cervix, by either our Stud Vet or one of our qualified AI technician's. At WKS we offer the following options:-

FRESH SEMEN

Only available from stallions standing at WKS (and walk-in by prior arrangement). Semen is collected from the stallion, combined with an appropriate extender and inseminated within a couple of hours. This is often the best option for mares that are having issues conceiving as it has the greatest longevity.

CHILLED SEMEN

Chilled semen must be ordered 12-36 hours prior to insemination (depending on the distance it has to travel). The semen is combined with an appropriate extender before being chilled to preserve it's mobility. Both Brexit and Covid related issues have adversely affected the reliability of shipments from the EU, so please let us know asap if this is your preferred choice. Suitable for most mares.

FROZEN SEMEN

Semen is cryopreserved before being stored in liquid nitrogen, allowing it to be stored indefinitely and transported worldwide. This makes it a great choice if the stallion is not in the UK, is busy competing, or has retired from stud/died. More veterinary intervention is required, making this the most expensive insemination option, and it is not suitable for all mares. We can advise whether your mare will be suitable and, if necessary, discuss alternative options.

EMBRYO TRANSFER

Embryo Transfer (ET) is a routine gynaecological procedure ideal for sports horse/competition mares that are unable to carry their own pregnancy, either due to a heavy competition schedule or medical complications, as the donor mare remains available to compete throughout. Fresh, chilled or frozen semen can be used. The donor mare is inseminated as normal and the resulting embryo is flushed from her uterus after she has ovulated (day 7 or 8) before being transferred into the recipient mare. A minimum of 2 potential recipient mares should be made available for synchronization (lining up) with the donor mare. The recipient mare is then scanned after 5-7 days (when the embryo is 12-14 days old), with follow up scans to confirm that a healthy pregnancy has been achieved.
