

### Set fee of £187.50 + VAT

This fee includes:

- **Post foaling examination of mare and foal**

The mare is examined for any damage to the external reproductive tract\*, to assess her milk supply and general wellbeing.

The afterbirth is examined for completeness and any abnormality.

The foal is examined for general wellbeing including colostrum intake, navel abnormality, meconium status and orthopaedic conformation.

The foal is given tetanus anti-toxin.

- **IgG Blood sample from the foal**

This checks that the foal has taken sufficient colostrum to ensure good immunity.

- **Foal I.D. and microchip for registration and passport application**

\*An ultrasound scan and endometrial swab is recommended at foal heat, 7-10 days after foaling, to ensure the uterus has recovered well. **This is not included in the package.**

**The package fee must be paid in full before work commences.**
